BEFORE ACCEPTANCE

- Review Veritas' Mission, Vision, Statement of Faith and Parent/Student Handbook found on our website VeritasGraysHarbor.com.
- Fill out, sign, and date the Enrollment Application form, and return it to us.
- Include a \$250 application fee per child with your Enrollment Application. Note that \$50 of this is non-refundable.
- Include a copy of any IEP or specialized plan your student was on elsewhere. Although we are not set up to service these plans, we would like the information to help the teachers plan for working with your student.
- Participate in the in-person family interview. Minimum attendees will be a parent or guardian, and all student applicants. Note that the Board reserves the right to not offer an interview to every family that applies.
- Students will take a brief skills test at the time of the interview. We will make a formal records request to the previous school, if applicable, should your child transfer to Veritas.
- Should you need tuition assistance, contact the school for current information.

AFTER ACCEPTANCE

- Submit a recent photo of each applicant, or a photo of the whole family.
- Submit copies of any legal documents (court orders, custody papers, etc.) that the school should keep on file.
- Make a tuition and fees payment for all accepted applicants by the due dates on the invoice that is sent to you via email to hold your place.
- Purchase uniforms and school supplies.
- Parents/Guardians or Grandparents who would like to volunteer should fill out and submit our Volunteer Application. A background check is required.

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- Per Child Application Fee \$250 due with application (\$50 Non-refundable per child)
- First Child Tuition \$6,000 per year
- Second Child Tuition \$5,400 per year

Clergy and Staff Discounts:

Full-time pastors of local Christian churches receive a 25% tuition discount for children enrolled.

Reduced Tuition Plan (RTP):

To apply for reduced tuition, submit a copy of your previous year's 1040 tax document, a copy of current pay stub, and a letter stating the reason for financial assistance and what you can afford.

Payment Schedule: Refer to the Parent/Student Handbook for more details.

A 2 % discount will apply to annual tuition fees paid in full prior to or on August 1st for the upcoming school year. Tuition can also be paid in ten monthly installments due on the 1st of each month, due from September 1 to June 1. Payments are considered late if received on or after the 6th of each month. Invoices will be emailed 30 days in advance. Non-sufficient funds will be levied a \$30 charge.

The following parental/family contract is required of all families enrolled in Veritas Classical Academy. Please read this carefully, fill out and sign in the spaces provided. Veritas Classical Academy and _____ do hereby enter into contract for the _____ academic year with the following understanding:

1. We pledge to uphold the academy consistently in prayer and to serve the academy with our time and talents as enabled according to God's leadership.
2. In keeping with scriptural principles (Matthew 18), we will bring any and all questions or areas of concern directly to the person(s) involved so that they may be properly considered. In addition, the academy desires to maintain open communication and will keep parents informed of changes in policy and procedures.
3. We agree to pay all fees and tuition for the academic year, and we will pay said fees and tuition on a timely basis. Furthermore, we understand that being delinquent in fees and/or tuition is sufficient grounds for removal from the school. After removal, no transcript or report card will be issued until money due the academy is paid. If a family chooses to withdraw before the end of the year, parents will be responsible to pay all tuition unless withdrawal is due to illness, job transfer, or loss of employment.
4. The academy reserves the right to dismiss any student who does not cooperate with the educational process as described in the Parent-Student Handbook. If a student is dismissed by the administration, the tuition will be prorated on a quarterly basis for the period of time the student was in the academy.
5. Scripture teaches that we honor God with our life and lifestyle. (Ephesians 5:1-21, Colossians 3:1-17) We promise, in humble reliance on the Holy Spirit, to be faithful in our church attendance and to strive to live in a manner that honors Christ. We further agree that the school administration has the authority to remove a student whose family, in the administration's judgment, is not honoring this commitment.
6. This contract may not be voided except by action of the Board of Directors. We have read the Parental Contract and Parent Student Handbook and hereby agree to its terms.
